Secret Sound

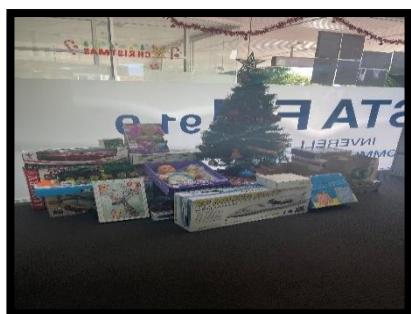

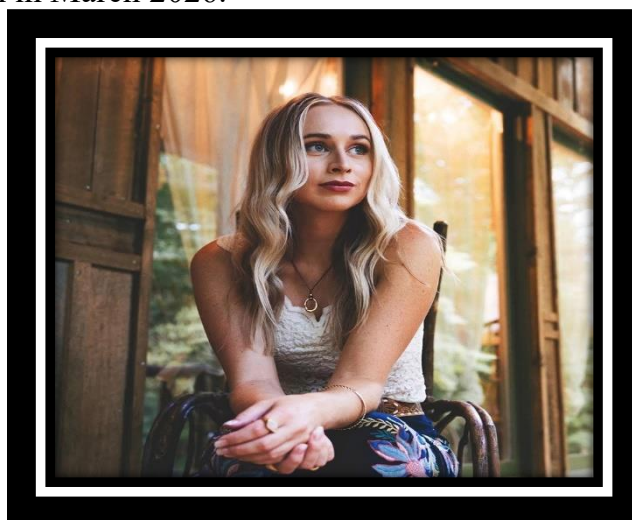
